Submissions may be on any subject and in any style. Keep in mind that the calendars represent the Bloomingdale Public Library and our group. Vulgarity, political statements, sermonizing and subjects that are inappropriate for family environments will not be accepted.

### **Deadline September 15, 2010**

Poems are limited to 20 lines including blank lines.

Short Stories, essays and abstracts of longer works must be no longer than 300 words, double spaced on 8 1/2 x 11" white paper with 1" margins, using Times New Roman 12 point format. **ALL SUBMISSIONS MUST BE IN WORD.**

### **Submissions should be critiqued at a meeting of the Writers Group.**

1. Submissions must be original work of the submitting author
2. Submissions must include author's name, address, phone number, and e-mail address. A signed copy of the permission form should be brought to one of the writer group meetings or emailed to John Flaherty, johnflare@aol.com.
3. The editorial committee will be solely responsible for the acceptance or rejection of all submissions and all decisions of the committee will be final.
4. In the event that editing is required, a member of the committee will confer with the author.
5. You may submit any number of submissions
6. Work should be final and ready for publishing.
